Types of emergencies

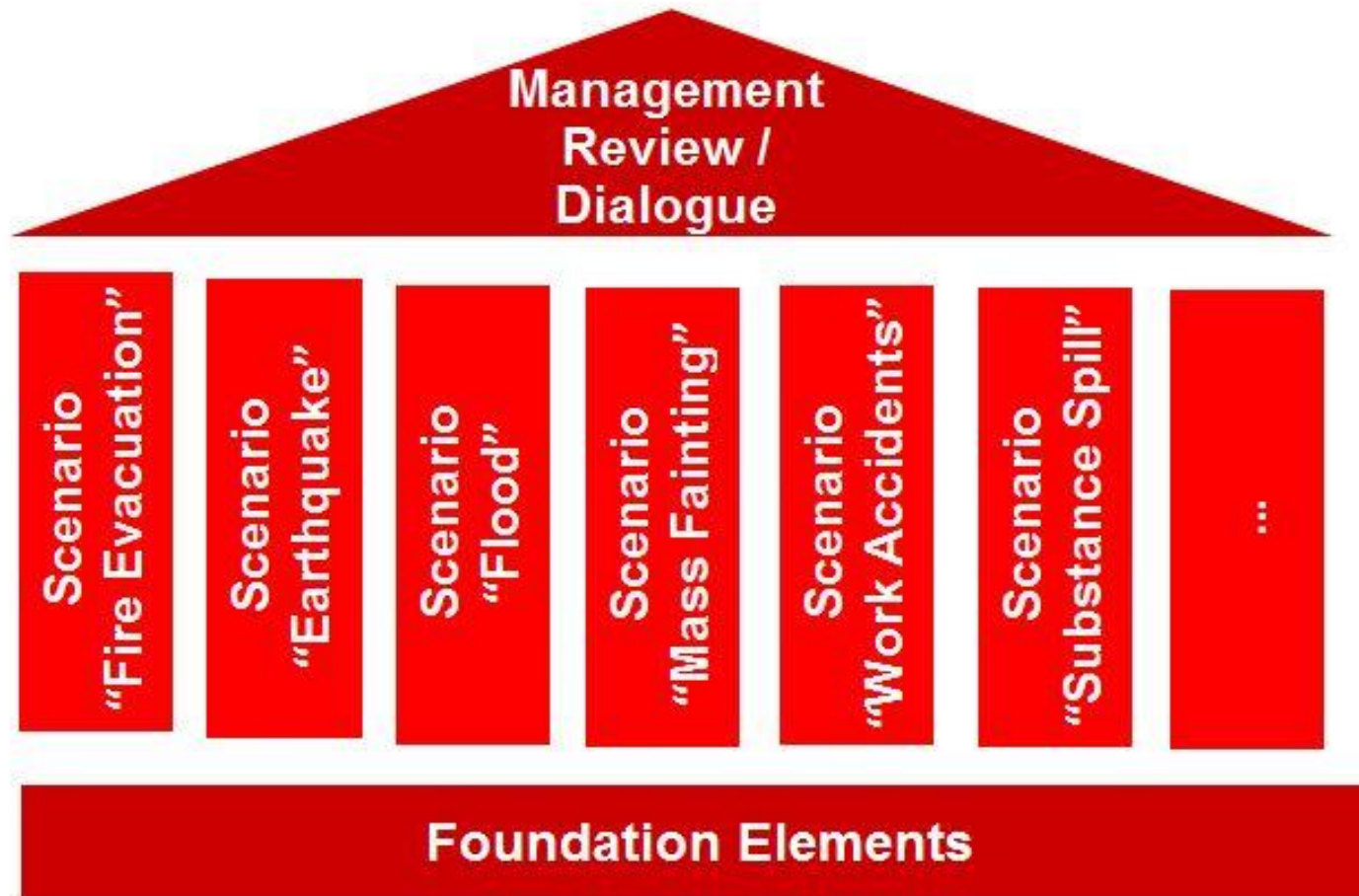
- ◆ earthquake
- ◆ landslide
- ◆ flood
- ◆ fire & explosion
- ◆ food poisoning
- ◆ mass fainting
- ◆ work accident
- ◆ hazardous substance spill & gas release



Potential negative consequences

- ◆ Death & injuries
- ◆ Interruption of production
- ◆ Reputational damage
- ◆ Industrial disputes
- ◆ Loss of contract
- ◆ Legal consequences (e.g. jail)
- ◆ Financial consequences
- ◆ Closure of factory
